What is Flipping the Classroom?

- ♪ Pedagogical model in which the typical lecture and homework elements of a class are reversed.
- ♪ Students are applying what they have learned from lectures in class rather than on their own.

Why Flip?

- ♪ Applying Bloom's Learning Cycle Taxonomy students most need assistance with the higher level activities, which is where the flipped method has students engaging with faculty and librarian experts.

Benefits of Flipping

- ♪ Creates a more student-centered and engaged learning environment.
- ♪ Improved outcomes.
