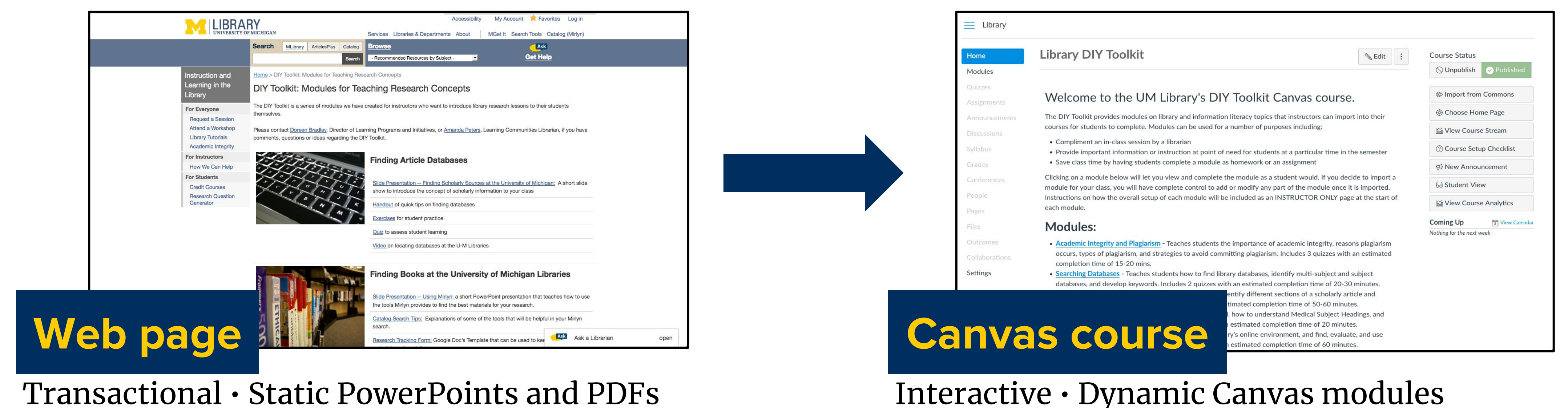
The Michigan Library Engagement Fellow Program provides engaged learning opportunities for students:

- Mentorship by university librarians

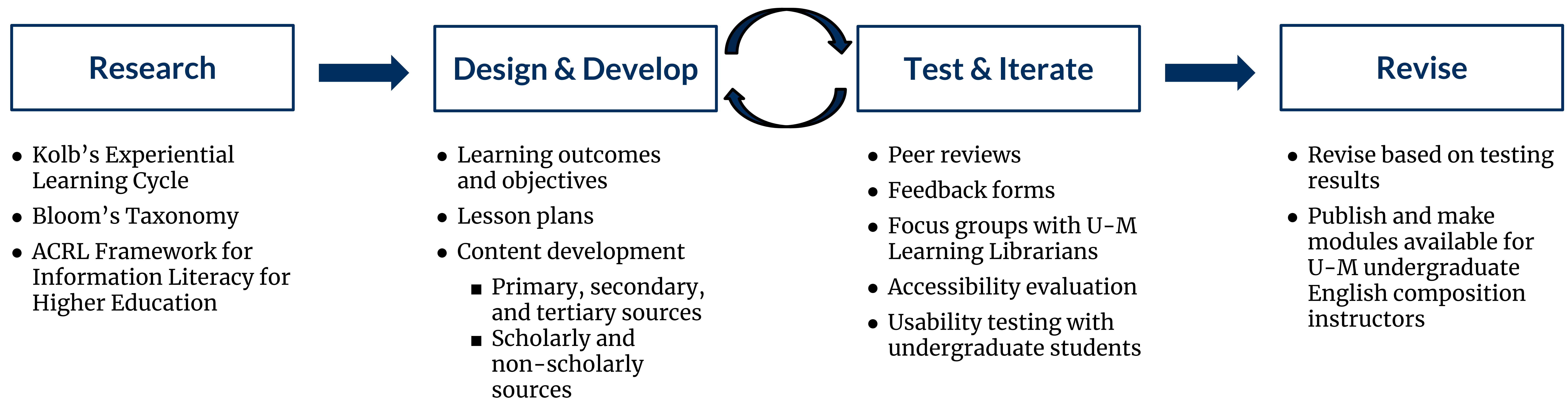
As part of the Instructional Design Project team, we translated research, learning theory, assessment, and technical knowledge into learner-centered instruction Canvas modules.
